




How do I add header and paragraph text blocks to a Membership Form?


Header Text Blocks and **Paragraph Text Blocks** allow you to add additional formatting or custom messaging to your Membership Form layout

To add a Header or Text Block to a Membership Form:


1. In the left-hand menu, click **Membership Forms > MEMBERSHIP FORMS**




2. **EDIT** the relevant form



3. Go to the **QUESTIONS AND LAYOUT** tab



4. At the bottom of the left-hand panel, add a **HEADER TEXT BLOCK** or a **PARAGRAPH TEXT BLOCK**.



5. **Header Text Blocks** allow you to define:

- **Header/Paragraph Text Block Name:** The name that you want to use to identify the header or paragraph text in your back-end form layout
- **Header/Paragraph Text Block Content:** The content of the header or paragraph text as it will be displayed on your Membership Form front-end. This field allows additional formatting options via the rich text editor

Click **SAVE** when you're ready
