

Club Finder Page (Accordian)

You can set up a club finder page if your organisation has clubs or even other organisations within your heirarchy. This article will outline how to set this page up as an **accoridan set up** which is basically a list page with contact information.

You can also set this up as a map type of club finder page.

NOTE: This add on has to be enabled for your organisation. To check if this is available for your website, check your website Dashboard.

- 1. Hover over **CONTENT**.
- 2. Click on **PAGES**.

3. Click **ADD NEW** against the PAGES heading.

5. On the right hand side of the page you will see a **PAGE ATTRIBUTES** menu. Under this menu, select the **CLUB FINDER PAGE ACCORDIA**N from the **TEMPLATE** drop down list.
